YOU'VE BEEN PAPERED

Pay a set fee for a colleague to have their desk "toilet papered" for the day. They can only remove it if they pay a fine. Sell tickets for staff to attend.

Put out a cute teddy and ask for donations to name it. Pick one at random or choose the best.

EXTREME CHALLENGE

Tough Mudder, Pretty Muddy, Total Warrior, Dunk & Escape.

10K STEP CHALLENGE

Go up against friends/colleagues in the 10K a day challenge. Anyone who fails to do 10K steps a day has to pay the penalty. Do it for a month.

YOUR MARATHON

A marathon doesn't have to mean running. Ask to be sponsored to do something that adds up to 26.2 miles e.g. walking on a treadmill. OR do something for 26.2 hours instead for a time marathon.

ZORB FOOTBALL

We have a set of Zorb Footballs for our supporters to use. Set up leagues, go up against other businesses or use them for fun. They are sure to bring you lots of giggles.









GIFT WRAPPING

Take the hassle out of wrapping and charge for the service.

CHOIR

Entertain friends/colleagues with some seasonal tunes and ask for donations.

ELF NAME

Choose an elf name and insist you are only addressed by this name for certain length of time (maybe a week, maybe the whole of December!) If they slip up and call you your real name they get a fine!

Host a festive evening and sell tickets.

CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY


Pay to wear your best (or worst) Christmas jumper.

NO CHRISTMAS CARDS

Instead of sending out Christmas cards, donate what you would have spent to HEY CU.

NEW YEAR'S "REVOLUTION"

Everyone signs up for something to mark the New Year e.g. a marathon, dry January, a mountain climb and asks for sponsorship. They don't all have to do the same thing. Just committing to something with lots of others is motivational and can encourage people to stick to it.





LAST HOUR'S PAY

We all know the last hour at work before the Christmas break can be a little less productive than others. Why not choose to donate that last hour's pay back to HEY CU to make up for it! It's Christmas after all.

YOU'VE BEEN TINSELLED!

Like "You've been papered" but with a festive twist (see office section). Think tinsel, baubles, glitter and lights. The more extreme the better!

SECRET SANTA

Instead of Secret Santa, donate what you would have spent to HEY CU. OR, reduce your budget by £1 and donate that spare £1 to charity.

how to set up fundraisers...



HOW TO SET UP FUNDRAISERS

Creating a fundraiser is easy and will only take a few minutes of your time. We can provide you with collection buckets, tshirts and more – just ask!

ONLINE FUNDRAISING

There are several websites where you can create a fundraising page, the main ones being Just Giving, Virgin Money Giving and Every Day Hero. We recommend our supporters use Just Giving as this is the only website that doesn't take a penny from the donations made to the page – others take a small percentage.

Go to www.justgiving.com and select "Start Fundraising". Select that you are fundraising for a charity. Register your details if you haven't already and then type Hull Children's University or The Hull CU Ltd in the charity search box.

You can then select whether you are taking part in an official event, celebrating an occasion, raising money in memory of someone or doing a personal challenge. If you can't find an event in the events search then you can add your own. Input your details into the form and your page is ready to go!

You can edit your page at any time. We recommend you personalise the text on the page to describe what you are going to be doing and why. The more personal, the better! You can set a fundraising target too and you can also select "extend fundraising page" if you want to make the page end sooner or later than the default 6 months after the event.

Once you are happy with your page then you are ready to share, share, share! There are buttons to instantly share on Facebook, Twitter and email. Or simply click "Visit my page" and copy and paste the web address from the URL box at the top of the screen. Any donations will come straight through to our charity's account so you don't need to do anything.

Your page is now set up and you are ready to raise lots of money!
